RAF Cosford is playing its part in keeping the carbon footprint down by delivering the official Mail around the Site on a tricycle. The Site includes the airfield, along with the Officers' and Sergeants' Mess Sites.



The three (Male) messengers are seen daily delivering the mail from building to building, however, they sometimes make use of a car to the airfield if there are heavy packages to deliver - or the wind is obstructing their pedal-power!

In addition, the messengers take turns in sorting the mail out in the Mail Room ready to be loaded onto their 'trusty' tricycles. The tricycles are subjected to a yearly service and a strict MOT!

This arrangement has been going on since the 60s, although before the tricycle it was as two-wheeler, which was never very practical as mail was restricted to what could be carried in a small box attached to the handlebars, and parking was somewhat more difficult with two wheels!
